## Homeschooling: how to teach your child at home

Remember yourself at school age: or You liked to get up at 7 am to <u>purchase essays online</u> get ready for school? For me it was eternal torture. Head stuck to the pillow, and at the request of my mother "Wake up or you'll be late" I did not react. At first the lessons were difficult to learn new material. Of course, my body could not so quickly "Wake up". Today students have the choice to learn remotely, or at school.

Actually, homeschooling can be even more useful than in the school. About the positive aspects of homeschooling said Elena Shulga, the cofounder of the project "COMPOL", and her son Nikita.

Who are homeschooler?

First, is the one who doesn't go to school or remotely attached to her. Second – he must learn himself. First, it is very difficult, now my parents help to learn. In General, homeschooling – this is when you fully learn myself, no one bothers you and does not help – says Nikita.

The only question is what to do if the child does not understand the formula or equation in geometry. Who to help him? Nikita says the student should seek additional information online. It is important to download itself to the maximum, he starts to get tired.

It's like in sports, – said Nikita. When you're not getting tired, you get nothing. And when you've reached your limit, begin to learn – then you can relax.

Elena Shulga believes that homeschooling – "it is a challenge for parents".

Children think that it is very easy to learn at home. But they have lessons last for 45 minutes and there are small breaks.

There is a term "rassharivanie" – that is, when the child finishes school and goes to home schooling and, of course, do not want to do. You think God, she so much misses! But you have to give time for the child to adapt, to log in to your own beat – not those "bells" that she had.

Elena Shulga explains the main reason why she and her son moved to home schooling. They decided to change the emphasis: Nikita spends more time on math and natural Sciences. And such a thing as music, it is not necessary. He attends a professional school, so time for studying other subjects he has enough.

Nikita admits that he misses the days when I was running down the corridor with his friends. And now he goes to clubs, and there also have children, so friends had enough.

Here arises another question: is furnished the student in a standard school? As evaluated?

Officially, we decorated on the external form of training. It provides that the child learns, and every year receives control work. There are schools that give control work once in a month and a half – you can often check on the baby, but she has less freedom because you can't deviate from the official program. In our school a test once a year. In may, he will receive them, fill in and send by mail. If it is not satisfied with the rating, he can go and protect this control – said Elena Shulga.

Elena admits that she is a supporter of the school, and was still certain barriers that interfere. Among her friends, many chose alternative education, or homeschooling. The family of Helen to this decision approached responsibly. Nikita is this format is suitable, so it does at home. Nikita tells that wakes up around 10 in the morning, fixing himself up and starts training.

Elena and Nikita said that at any moment you can refer to a tutor or counselor and ask your questions. Generally, 7 the grader likes to study at home.

In any case, the choice depends on the decision of the child and parents. We always listen to each other's opinions.

Homeschooling – this is not a standard approach to learning. For some it became a life style. The parents in this case play the role of a tutor – they are always there, ready at any moment to help, to listen and support.
